CASTLETON, VT, February 14, 2012 --- The flames at The Forge were burning bright in December when special visitors Kevin O'Connor, host of *This Old House*®, and crew went on a road trip to Castleton, Vermont.

On December 13, 2011, the Emmy Award-winning PBS home improvement series filmed the production processes of Vermont's own, hand-made lighting company, Hubbardton Forge, whose decorative fixtures are featured exclusively in the 2012 *This Old House*® project home in Barrington, RI.

From design concept through finished products, show host Kevin O'Connor explored the great craftsmanship inherent to not only Hubbardton Forge products, but to the roots of the 25-year-old home improvement show itself.

The filming also highlighted the forging of the company's iconic Twist Basket fixture as well as the new-for-2011, solid steel, folded Mobius pendant.
